- Application to Ozarks Technical Community College (OTC)
- Application to Behavioral Health Support Program deadline October 25th
- <u>3 Professional References</u> (academic, work performance, and potential to function in health care field)
- Attend OTC <u>Allied Health Advising session</u>
- Complete required <u>admission interview</u> (professionalism & career goals)
- Pass complete background check and negative drug screen

- Employment possibilities EXCELLENT
- Entry-level positions:
  - Community Support Specialist
  - Community mental health centers
